

Minutes of the Aldbrough Parish Council Meeting held on the 10th August 2009 in the Aldbrough Primary School at 7.30 p.m.

Members present - Councillor S. Turner (Chairman), Councillors K. Blackwell, T. Floater, J. Fox, M. Robinson, D. Smith, M. Teale.

Apologies received from Councillors T. Handley and G. North.

Councillor M. Robinson reported ERYC Grants Officer Kelly Childs sent her apologies for not attending the meeting because the plans for the play area had not been finalised, another meeting to be arranged down at the recreation field with the proposed plans, all Councillors to be informed.

Public Forum - no public in attendance.

The Minutes of the previous meeting held on the 13th July 2009 were duly approved and signed.

Matters arising:-

Councillor S. Turner reported that all the paperwork had been sent to the Bishop's Office regarding the consecration. Concreting the existing path in the cemetery was discussed, Councillor S. Turner to measure the area and present a quotation to the next meeting.

Councillor S. Turner reported that Councillor T. Handley had found out that the War Memorial Society/Planning Officer ERYC had no objections to adding names to the War Memorial. The Clerk to find out the price of a brass plaque/marble plinth.

Road Safety Hornsea Road - The Traffic Survey was in the process of being assessed by Safety Roads Humber and the Parish Council would be contacted with the findings. Councillor M. Robinson mentioned Community Speedwatch but the Parish Council had to fund the camera. With the view of applying for a Lollypop person, Margaret Millburn Road Safety ERYC to do a survey regarding children crossing Hornsea Road in September, the date to be confirmed with the Clerk. A letter was read out from Phil Hiscott ERYC regarding the criteria for zebra crossings.

Allotment holder's complaint regarding spraying - matter resolved.

Felling of 1 Elm tree Wentworth Grove - on the job sheet dated 27th July 2006 to be done in the Autumn by Streetscene.

Town & Country Planning Act 1990

(Councillor K. Blackwell declared his personal interest in this item and did not take part in the discussion) - Erection of detached garage to rear at 32 Carlton Lane Aldbrough for Mrs N. Wright - full planning permission - **Approved**. Councillor J. Fox brought it to the attention of the Council that the address on the application form only was 32 Carlton Drive - the Clerk to inform ERYC when sending back the decision.

Decision by ERYC - (Councillor M. Teale declared his interest) - Retention of solar panels to rear at Wentworth House 12 Seaside Road Aldbrough for Mark Teale - **Approved**.

Councillor M. Robinson brought up the matter of a hedge that had grown into a tree Cedar Grove/Willow Grove by parishioner Mrs P. Auty. Councillor S. Turner to look into the matter and report back to the next meeting.

Councillor T. Floater mentioned the hedge and paths Carlton Lane. He would contact the owners of Mill Bungalow - to be put on Streetscene list for the Autumn.

Councillor T. Floater reported fly tipping down Dothams as it was a green lane, ERYC to be contacted for action.

Councillor J. Fox reported that he and Mrs Fox had attended the Yorkshire Day Celebrations on the Council's behalf.

Councillor D. Smith asked for permission to purchase new materials for the bridge

repairs Etherdwick footpath. Permission granted.

Councillor M. Robinson mentioned that David Hunt, Carlton Lane would like to be considered to be a first responder if the scheme became available in Aldbrough. As this was the result of the Parish Plan, Councillor M. Teale volunteered to contact Karen Wood for further advice. It was also thought that Councillor T. Handley would be interested.

Councillor M. Robinson reported that he had attended a meeting at Bainton ten weeks ago regarding a different type of heating (heat exchanger) as previously mentioned in the Minutes but as yet had had no follow up.

The Clerk to contact BCTV regarding maintenance of trees on the recreation field. Councillor M. Robinson to mark the trees that need replacing.

Councillor M. Robinson reported the new gully just past Carlton Drive was open-toothed and not flush to the tarmac of the road and as a ball and tins were floating on the water it was felt that it could be a danger to the public especially children.. The Clerk to contact ERYC for advice. A copy to be forwarded to Ward Councillor M. Grove.

The hedge adjoining Nottingham Road/Wentworth Grove bungalows had been cut and the weeds underneath sprayed causing the soil to run onto the road in wet weather. The Clerk to contact ERYC for advice.

The Clerk to contact HAPS regarding cutting the rough area of ground at the recreation field as it was in the quotation that the area would be cut 2/3 times a year.

There being no further business, the Vice-Chairman closed the meeting, the next one to be held on Monday 14th September 2009.
