

## ALDBROUGH PARISH COUNCIL

### **Minutes of the meeting held on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> December 2009 in the Aldbrough County Primary School at 7.30 p.m.**

**Apologies** received from Councillors D. Smith and M. Robinson.

Damien Brook Constituency Secretary to Graham Stuart MP gave a presentation regarding coastal erosion and various opinions were expressed. It was hoped that an exhibition/public meeting to be held in the village hall at the beginning of March 2010 to be organised by Damien Brook who was also thanked for his attendance.

**Public Forum** - no comments made.

The Minutes of the previous meeting held on the 9<sup>th</sup> November 2009 were approved and signed.

#### **Matters arising:-**

**Cemetery** - Councillor S. Turner reported that the new extension had been consecrated on the 4<sup>th</sup> December 2009 by the Bishop of Hull. A letter of thanks to be sent to Penny Turner for her contribution towards the refreshments. The two quotations by F. Kemp & Son/Barker & Grantham Ltd for the concrete roadway at the cemetery were discussed, the Council accepted the tender by F. Kemp & Son - Councillor S. Turner to be contacted before any work commenced.

**Affordable Housing** - The Clerk to contact Chevin Housing regarding their concern over the proposed entrance of the site on to Garton Road and being so near the play area entrance of the recreation field. It was agreed that Councillor M. Robinson should be the Parish Council's representative for the scheme.

**War Memorial** - it was decided to accept the quotation by Everinghams of £217.35 for the proposed inscription.

**Festive Xmas Tree** - Councillors G. North, S. Turner and M. Robinson involved in the erection of the Christmas Tree. Letter of thanks to be sent to Gerry Bond, Liaison Officer E-on for supplying the lights, L. McDermott for the electrical work, Guy Leonard whose staff helped in transporting the tree which Councillor M. Robinson kindly donated.

Playarea Recreation Field - matter ongoing.

Councillor G. North gave his report on the Flooding Meeting held on 11/11/2009.

Ward Councillor M. Grove reported on the Play Area Queensmead, he volunteered to investigate the matter further.

Emergency Planning - The Chairman volunteered to co-ordinate.
