

Minutes of the Aldbrough Parish Council Meeting held on the 13th July 2009 in the Aldbrough Primary School at 7.30 p.m.

Members present - Councillor T. Handley (Chairman) Councillors K. Blackwell, T. Floater, J. Fox, G. North, M. Robinson, D. Smith, M. Teale, S. Turner. Public - S. Cantwell, Mr & Mrs Denniss.

Councillor D. Smith was appointed Parish Paths/Sustainability Officer and Councillor J. Fox Planning Officer.

Kelly Charles, ERYC Grants Officer gave an up to date comprehensive report on the proposed new play area at the village hall following consultations with parishioners. Two Police representatives were also present and a long discussion ensued regarding anti-social behaviour, playing of football North Street etc. It was reported that results of the traffic survey would be e-mailed to the Clerk as soon as possible. Kelly Childs to arrange to meet with Councillor Robinson and the ERYC's Engineer and to keep both Councillor Robinson and the Clerk informed of all developments.

Public Forum - Mrs Denniss expressed her appreciation to the Parish Council/ERYC for hopefully the new play area so that the children of the village would have somewhere safe to play and keep them off the village streets.

The Minutes of the previous meeting held on the 8th June 2009 were duly approved and signed.

Matters arising:-

Cemetery matters - Councillor S. Turner reported the new footpath in the cemetery extension would be completed this evening. The Petition for Consecration was duly signed and witnessed by the Chairman and Vice-Chairman. The state of the existing concrete path from the cemetery gates was discussed and it was decided that the Highways Department be contacted for advice regarding resurfacing.

44 Hornsea Road - matter closed as per the Highways Department findings.

Elm Grove Play area - matter ongoing.

Fence Seaside Road - matter ongoing.

Risk Assessment Disc - Councillor K. Blackwell distributed risk assessment sheets to Councillors to fill in so that the Annual Return to the Audit Commission could be completed by 31st July 2009.
