

ALDBROUGH PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the meeting held on the 11th May 2009 in the Aldbrough Primary School at 7.30 p.m.

Members present - Councillors T. Handley (Chairman), J. Fox, G. North, M. Robinson, D. Smith, M. Teale, S. Turner, Ward Councillor M. Grove. Parishioners - C. Cantwell and daughter, K. Ellis.

Apologies received from Councillor K. Blackwell

The Minutes of the previous meeting held on the 20th April 2009 were approved and signed.

Matters arising:-

Cemetery Matters - Councillor S. Turner reported that the Clerk was awaiting to hear from the Archbishop of York regarding consecration of the new part of the cemetery.

Footpaths - Councillor D. Smith reported that he would be negotiating with Councillor S. Turner regarding wood needed for repairing two footbridges. The approved grant from the ERYC should be arriving shortly. He was still in the process of obtaining copies of the footpath maps with Andrew Chudley ERYC.

Parish Plan - Councillor M. Teale reported that the Parish Plan had been printed and would be distributed after the last meeting of the Parish Plan Committee the following Thursday. There had been an underspend of the Awards for All Grant closing date 15th May 2009 and a discussion took place regarding new notice boards, rubbish bin and a village information board. The Clerk to enquire whether the underspend would be available to fund any of these projects.

The Chairman stated that he had had a preview of the Parish Plan and he thanked the Parish Plan Committee members for all their hard work in producing such a professional and informative document.

Coastal protection update - Councillor M. Robinson gave a comprehensive update on the meeting organised by Captain E. Todd on the 8th May 2009 in the village hall and stated that the meeting was not about the experimental groynes but the Shoreline Management Plan. Members expressed their views and concerns. Ward Councillor M. Grove stated that "roll back" not only applied to caravan sites but also to private individuals.

In Councillor K. Blackwell's absence, Councillor G. North brought up the matter of the ownership of the piece of land Elm Grove/Queensmead. It was thought to be a designated play area but the Clerk would look into the matter with the ERYC.

Councillor D. Smith as previously reported said he would endeavour to obtain a list of the receiptants from the Holderness Learning and Development Fund.

Councillor J. Fox queried the whereabouts of the Parish Council owned lawnmowers. Three machines were accounted for. The Allotment Holders had requested the push along machine be made available to cut the strip of grass down the middle of the allotments. A discussion ensued regarding the compost heap, rubbish heap and small shed for storage.

Councillor M. Robinson brought up the matters of an application for grant funding for new play area equipment received from the ERYC for designated play areas. Closing date for applications 23rd May 2009. He would make the necessary application for the village hall play area.

Councillors Turner and Robinson to look at the allotment grant funded hedging around the area of the allotments.

Fence Seaside Road - The Clerk to contact ERYC for advice.

Councillors J. Fox and D. Smith gave their apologies for the June meeting. There being no further business, the Chairman closed the meeting. The next one to be held on **Monday 8th June 2009.**
