

**ALDBROUGH PARISH COUNCIL**  
**Minutes of the meeting held on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> October 2009 in the Aldbrough**  
**Primary School at 7.30 p.m.**

**Mr G. Bond, Liaison Officer, E.on** gave an update on the present situation of the planning application regarding the Whitehill Gas Storage Project with regard to two recently approved schemes in the vicinity of the Project, modifications to the Project's AGI boundary, changes in the development plan position and options for beach access. Councillor D. Smith volunteered to make copies of the DVD on the Environmental Scoping Report for Councillors. Mr Bond was asked to enquire whether E.on would be kind enough to sponsor festive lights and the services of an electrician for the proposed Christmas tree in the churchyard.
