

## ALDBROUGH PARISH COUNCIL

### Minutes of the meeting held on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> September 2009 in the Aldbrough Primary School at 7.30p.m.

**Members present** - Councillors T. Handley (Chairman), K. Blackwell, T. Floater, J. Fox, G. North, M. Robinson, D. Smith, M. Teale, S. Turner. Ward Councillor M. Grove. Member of the public - S. Cantwell. **Apologies** from Karen Wood, ERYC.

**A presentation** was given by Mr Richard Caley, Biomass Power Station, Tansterne regarding a community led scheme for piping hot water from the power station into the village. Mr Caley was advised to contact Paul Bolotti, Renewable Energy Sustainability Officer, ERYC to seek further advice regarding the scheme.

**Kelly Charles, ERYC** attended the meeting regarding the Pathfinders Scheme in regard to the new playground at the village hall, permission was given to go ahead with the scheme, the Clerk to confirm in writing. A discussion took place regarding a kickwall, separate negotiations to take place between Alastair Cleland SSE and Councillor M. Robinson.

**Public Forum** - no comments made.

**The Minutes** of the previous meeting held on 10<sup>th</sup> August 2009 were approved and signed.

#### **Matters arising:-**

**Cemetery matters** - Councillor S. Turner reported a letter had been received from L. Lennox, Legal Secretary to the Archbishop of York stating that the footpath which runs east/west across the extension will be constructed within a few months of consecration if the footpath has not been constructed when the land is consecrated. The Clerk to confirm in writing that this request will be carried out. A discussion ensued regarding the various paths in the cemetery/extension, Councillor S. Turner to look into the matter.

**War Memorial** - The Clerk to contact Everinghams regarding adding an inscription in memory of M. Murphy 22SAS Borneo 1963. The Chairman reported that Rev. S. Rice-Oxley would be willing to officiate a service of dedication.

**Road Safety Hornsea Road** - A report received from Will Stephenson Local Community Police Officer was thoroughly discussed, a copy would be handed to local resident D. Holdsworth showing the findings. M. Millburn ERYC to be contacted regarding a date for the survey of schoolchildren crossing Hornsea Road.

**Update on discussion with residents re Coastal Change Policy** - Councillor M. Teale reported no action.

**Update closure of Camp Site Road** - The Chairman read a letter received from David Allison Aldbrough Leisure Park. Councillor G. North volunteered to move the blocks further back if it would mean that the road could be kept open a bit longer, Ward Councillor to report this suggestion to the Highways Department, ERYC.

**Hedge/Tree Cedar Grove/Willow Grove** - No action, the Clerk to contact the complainant.

**Flytipping Dothams** - Councillor S. Turner had inspected the lane and it was suggested that any persons who were fly tipping, vehicle numbers should be taken if possible so that action could be taken. Councillor G. North made it known that he was concerned residents were walking through his crops which was private land.

**Gully Carlton Lane** - The Chairman read a letter from M. Peeke, ERYC.

**Grass Verge Nottingham Road** - no action from ERYC.

**Hedge Queensmead** - no action.

**Town & Country Planning Act 1990** - Erection of a conservatory to the rear of 4 Meadow Rise Aldbrough for Mrs L. Parsons - Approved.

**Decisions by ERYC** - Change of use from shop to additional living accommodation 18 Church Street Aldbrough for Mr N. Moore - Approved subject to condition.  
Erection of detached garage to rear at 32 Carlton Lane Aldbrough for Mrs Wright - Approved subject to conditions.

Hedge near the cemetery overgrown - advice to be sought.

Councillor M. Robinson requested that it be recorded that the play area and the Pathfinder play equipment funded by the ERYC should not be the responsibility of the Village Hall for maintenance/insurance purposes. No decision made.

The holes in the surface of the road Nottingham Road be reported to Highways Dept.

The Clerk reported that an allotment tenancy had been terminated, it was granted that Mrs V. Denniss North Street be allocated the tenancy as per the Waiting List.

The Clerk reported M. Peeke Highways ERYC had reported that the brown directional signs for the Church had been placed on order. ERYC had reported that the Dog Control Orders had gone through full Council and implementations of the orders will be forwarded in the near future.
